Prerequisite: Intro to ArcGIS

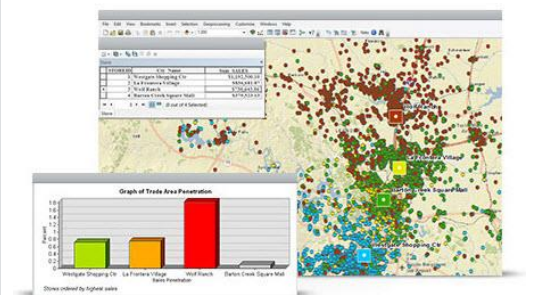
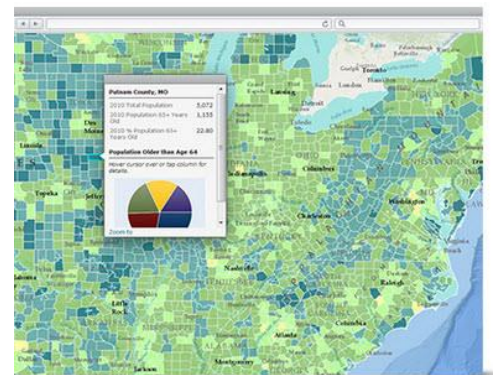
